want to make it easier for international degree students to integrate into the Finnish job market. The Vaasa International Talents programme is a bridge between international degree students and the employers in the region.













What, where and when?

The program runs from October 2024 to February 2025 in Vaasa. At the end of Module 1, which spans from October to December, you will need to submit your learning journal for review. This submission is required to secure your seat in Module 2, running from January to February.

You need to apply to the programme. Since the programme activities are planned take to place on site in Vaasa, you need to be physically present in order to be able to participate.

The aim is to provide all programme participants with various possibilities to develop their Finnish working life skills and to connect with regional companies and other actors. You will get excellent possibilities to network with fellow programme participants, cross degree programmes and higher education institutions.

The success of the programme from your personal perspective will largely depend on your active participation, initiative and contribution.

All programme participants who have completed the programme will at the end of the programme receive a certificate of participation.

The programme consists of three focus areas:

- 1 Competence development Skills for Finnish working life
- 2 Individual coaching
- 3 Connections to working life

Please note that the programme is not part of your individual study plan and will therefore not automatically give you any credit points. The possibility to earn credit points from programme participation will be entirely a matter between you and your degree programme.

Competence development – Skills for Finnish working life

This part of the programme consists of two modules. It equips the participants with must-know facts about Finnish and local working life and its expectations on job applicants and employees. This part kicks off end of October 2024. It will include:

- guest lectures on different topics
- personal journeys
- group discussions
- assigned tasks which will support your personal and professional development

Individual coaching

One-on-one meetings with a coach to give you personalized tips and advice and, discuss your professional interests and field. It includes:

- feedback on your job application materials
- simulation of a job interview

Connections to working life

The following activities will vary from participant to participant:

- job shadowing
- company visits
- other types of networking possibilities

We cannot guarantee that you will get any of these possibilities through the programme, since they will be dependent on the needs and availability of the working life actors. What we can guarantee, however, is that by actively participating in the programme, you will be able to find your own connections to working life actors.



Time investment needed:

The estimated required time investment in the lectures and individual coaching is **roughly 25 hours**. In addition, you will need to reserve time between the sessions for keeping a journal of your learning and for work on your job application materials and other related assigned tasks. With a few exceptions, all sessions will be held on site on Wednesdays after office hours. Please see further down the dates for the planned sessions. At the end of Module 1, you will need to hand in your learning journal for review in order to secure a seat on Module 2.

- you are an international Master student in one of the following programmes
- you are an international Bachelor student and you have completed at least your first year of studies in one of the following programmes
- you have graduated from any of the following programmes since September 2023

When and how to apply?

The programme is open for application from Monday 9th September 2024 at 08:00 hrs.

The application period closes on <u>Sunday 6th October 2024 at 23:59 hrs.</u>

Please only apply if you are really prepared to be present, to invest the time and energy needed to complete the programme!

To apply to the programme, please do the following:



Create a video of max. 2 minutes' length where you:

- Start by introducing yourself briefly in Finnish or Swedish by telling who
 you are and what you are studying and in which higher education
 institution.
- Thereafter continue elaborating in English on the following:
 - What do you want to develop as person and/or professional?
 - How do you think you can contribute to the group and group discussions?

Attach a link to your CV

(from LinkedIn, OneDrive, Google Drive, Youtube or the like) to the application form. Make sure the document is in <u>PDF format and name the file as follows:</u>
Name_Surname_CV. For example: John_Smith_CV.



Attach a link to your video presentation

(from LinkedIn, OneDrive, Google Drive, Youtube or the like) to the application form. Make sure the file is in .mov or .mp4 format and name the file as follows: Name_Surname_Video. For example: John_Smith_Video.

Please be extra careful with ensuring that the links to your CV and video presentation are accessible in your application, as well as throughout the programme. An application which includes non-accessible links will be considered as incomplete.



Selection

30 students will be selected to the programme.

Seats will be reserved for students from each higher education institution.

As for Bachelor students, priority will be given to students on 2nd year and onwards.

The programme reserves the right to select the participants.

The **final selections** will be made **by mid-October**. All applicants to the programme will

be informed once the selections have been completed.

Please note that incomplete applications will be discarded.

What we expect from you?

We expect the selected participants to

- be physically present in Vaasa
- attend the "Competence development Skills for Finnish working life" sessions
- attend the individual coaching sessions
- keep a learning journal throughout the programme. At the end of the programme
 this journal will include your personal reflections and insights related to what you
 learn during the lectures, discussions, coaching sessions, etc.
- at the end of Module 1 you will need to hand in your learning journal for review, in order to secure a seat on Module 2.
- complete other related tasks, such as work on job application materials.
- actively contribute to learning from each other by sharing questions, insights, lessons learned and best practices etc. with the other participating students, companies and other working life actors.
- actively network with the other students in the programme.
